# ★ GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS ★

- **The Intra-Dayananda Sagar college events planned exclusively for Day 1 are free of charge; no registration fee is required for any of them.**
- **Dayananda Sagar teams that secure victories on Day 1 will need to pay the registration fee to participate on Day 2.**
- **Teams from other colleges are required to pay the registration fee and will participate directly on Day 2.**
- **Only one team from each college is permitted to represent music, dance, theatre, and fashion respectively.**
- **The judgement will be made by a professional. The judge's decision is final and cannot be questioned.**
- **If registrations for any event exceed expectations, preliminary rounds may be conducted before the fest.**
- **No vulgarity.**
- **No profanity.**
- **No hate speech towards any caste, creed, religion, language, or region.**
- **Costumes insinuating exhibitionism will not be tolerated. The following items are prohibited – alcohol, lighters, cigarettes, vapes, hookah, e-cigarettes, drugs, flammable objects, perfumes, deodorants, contraceptives, liquids, medicines, edibles, sharp objects or weapons such as pocket knives, razors and so on. Items once confiscated will not be returned.**

Rules:

- Teams can perform in Kannada, Hindi, or English
- Props can be used.
- Synopsis of the act should be produced to the co-ordinator two days before the performance.
- Judges' decisions will be final and binding.

The event is divided into two halves - The first round is a team participation following which, each member of the qualifying teams must pick a sub-event to proceed. Upon completion of both rounds, the scores will be tallied to declare a winner.

**Note:** Each team must register under one representative, not as 3 registrations.

### Round 1

- The teams must all answer a quiz.
- The points will be totalled and elimination will take place.
- The 3 members must each pick a sub-event for Round 2: Creative writing, Elocution and Aircrash.

### Round 2

- Participant 1 chooses creative writing with an on-spot prompt. The contestant is free to choose any style or language of writing to deliver a piece within a set time limit.
- The second participant must prepare a speech on a given topic and deliver it with poise and clarity. The judgment criteria include content, coherence, relevance to the topic, and bonus points for outstanding performance. The topic will be disclosed on-spot and preparation time will be granted. Use of reference sheets is permitted and phones are disallowed.
- The third and last participant of the team must take charge of being the most relevant part of any trio - the comic. The contestant will be given a character or famous personality to emulate in speech and action. The catch? They're on a crashing plane with only one parachute. Fight the clock to imminent death and claim your right to life - all while competing against personalities like Alia Bhatt, Obama, or even Voldemort.

### **General instructions:**

- The scoresheet will decide the winners. Disclosure of the same is at the discretion of the judge.
- Absence of a member will result in lower scores, but the team may proceed to round 2. All teams must be registered and present at the event before the commencement of the first round.
- The use of foul language, profanity, vulgarity, or personal attacks will lead to immediate disqualification.
- The judge and coordinators hold the final say. Their decision is final and binding, any issues or queries must be directly dealt with by the coordinators.
